SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor or Designate, operates a variety of heavy duty equipment relative to the construction and maintenance of buildings and grounds.

DUTIES

- 1. Operates equipment, vehicles, trucks and tractors, with or without attachments, and/or in combination with trailer units.
- 2. Installs and maintains playfield and playground components such as fences, gates, goal posts, basketball hoops and playground equipment using site plans and working drawings.
- 3. Constructs, renovates and maintains playfields including fertilizing/liming, dressing, aerating, seeding and rock picking.
- 4. Installs and/or maintains blacktop and concrete on small projects.
- 5. Directs and assists other employees.
- 6. May be required to train other employees in the operation of specific equipment as directed.
- 7. Orders materials as needed.
- 8. Will, on occasion, be required to perform other job-related duties as assigned.
