SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor or Designate, operates land moving equipment to develop and maintain playing fields, parking areas, roadways, underground systems and landscaping.

DUTIES

- 1. Operates a grader and/or a backhoe and performs a variety of site related duties.
- 2. Provides first-line maintenance to machines operated.
