## SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Maintenance Manager or designate, installs, alters, and maintains plumbing, water and sewer systems and ancillary equipment.

## DUTIES

- 1. Installs, alters, repairs, and maintains plumbing and hot water heating, equipment, devices, and fixtures.
- 2. Installs, alters, repairs, and maintains piped equipment, devices, and appliances.
