SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor or Designate, installs, repairs and maintains roofs and buildings, grounds and ancillary equipment.

DUTIES

- 1. Installs, alters, repairs, and maintains roofs.
- 2. Constructs, installs, repairs and maintains buildings, furnishings, equipment and carpentry-related grounds projects.
- 3. Performs all carpenter duties and works in related areas such as concrete, millwork, glass replacement, drywall and floor coverings.
- 4. Directs, assists and liaises with other employees, contractors, regulatory agencies and other trades, as required.
- 5. Designs projects, reads and interprets drawings and prepares cost estimates.
- 6. May on occasion be required to perform other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

- High school graduation or the equivalent.
- Successful completion of the B.C. Apprenticeship Program and a valid B.C. Trade Certification as a Carpenter.
- Minimum of two years related experience at the journeyman level.
- Roofing experience or a demonstrated ability to learn roofing techniques.
- Physical capability to perform the job duties.
