SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor or Designate, installs, alters and conducts systematic maintenance of electrical systems and equipment.

DUTIES

- Upgrades and modifies existing electrical distribution systems and installs new systems as required.
- 2. Repairs, alters, installs and systematically maintains electronic and micro processor-driven systems such as fire alarm, security alarm, lighting and control system and conducts periodic testing, reporting as required.
- 3. Installs computer network wiring.
- 4. Installs and maintains motors, motorized equipment and associated controls, power tools, appliances and other electrical equipment.
- 5. Installs and maintains electrical heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems and the power and control aspects of other HVAC systems.
- Designs projects, reads and interprets drawings and specifications and prepares cost estimates.
- 7. Directs, assists and liaises with employees, contractors, regulatory agencies and other trades, as required.
- 8. May on occasion be required to perform other related duties as assigned.

- Two years related experience at the journeyman level.
