

Position: Elementary Teacher		
The employee carries out educational tasks such as establishing learning objectives and specifying the strategies and actions to achieve these objectives, identifying educational needs, developing and/or developing educational programs or activities, and teaching or instructing students.		
Functions	<p>Elementary school teachers perform some or all of the following duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare courses for presentation to students according to approved curriculum • Teach students using a systematic plan of lessons, discussions, audio-visual presentations and field trips • Lead students in activities to promote their physical, mental and social development and their school readiness • Assess students and evaluate results • Discuss results with students, parents and school officials • Identify children's individual learning needs • Participate in the preparation and implementation of remedial programs for students requiring extra help • May be expected to supervise educational assistants and student teachers. • Elementary school may specialize in such areas as special education or second language instruction.
