## **SUMMARY**

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor or Designate, is responsible for the operation and maintenance of heating and ancillary equipment in the District facilities.

## **DUTIES**

- 1. Installs, services and repairs oil, gas and electric heating plants and ancillary equipment in District facilities, except for those schools where there is a designated power engineer.
- 2. Repairs and maintains roof top forced air heating plants, domestic hot water boiler and all associated ancillary equipment.
- 3. Designs projects, reads and interprets drawings and specifications and prepares cost estimates.
- 4. Directs, assists and liaises with employees, contractors, regulatory agencies and other trades, as required.
- Maintains records on inventory, servicing, supplies, trouble shooting and provides data to supervisor.
- 6. Maintains pneumatic, electrical and computerized control systems.
- 7. May on occasion be required to perform other related duties as assigned.
