SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor or designate, is responsible for the design layout, installation and maintenance School District grounds and associated equipment.

DUTIES

- 1. Designs, installs, alters and maintains all grounds related facilities, including playfields, playgrounds, gardens, landscaping and all of the associated infrastructure.
- 2. Designs, installs and maintains irrigation systems.
- 3. Installs and maintains playfield and playground components such as fences, gates, goal posts, basketball hoops and playground equipment using site plans and working drawings.
- 4. Operates equipment, vehicles, trucks and tractors, with or without attachments and/or in combination with trailer units.
- 5. Recommends for approval and purchases all grounds related materials.
- 6. Assists in determining, altering and administering a "District Grounds Program."
- 7. Directs, advises or assists other employees as required.
- 8. Prepares design/layout and cost estimates for grounds projects.
- 9. Prepares and applies pesticides and other chemicals in accordance with the current Pesticide Control Act and trade practices for the control of weeds, undesirable growth and pests.
- 10. Maintains records and reports on stocks of all grounds related materials.
- 11. Will on occasion be required to perform other job related duties as assigned.

- Two years related experience at the journeyman level.

- Ability to read and interpret drawings and specifications
- Physical capability to perform the job duties
- Competent in the use and care of tools and equipment common to this trade
