	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use of technological tools and software in developing courses and curriculum material for presentation to students according to approved curriculum within a Web-based learning and teaching environment.</li><li>• Use of technological tools and software in assessing students, evaluating, and communicating results within a Web-based learning and teaching environment.</li><li>• Use of technological tools and software in the preparation and implementation of remedial programs in a Web-based learning and teaching environment for students requiring extra help.</li><li>• Use of technological tools and software in developing, modifying, adapting, and delivering curriculum and learning material in order to meet the needs of disabled, learning challenged, and/or behavior challenged students in a Web-based learning and teaching environment.</li><li>• Use of technological tools and software in making adjustments to instructional approaches and assessment practices to accommodate individual differences of students in a Web-based learning and teaching environment.</li><li>• Use of a Learning Management Systems (eg. BlackBoard), and Web 2.0 tools in a Web-based learning and teaching environment.</li><li>• Use of synchronous (eg. Collaborate) and asynchronous (eg. Blogs or Discussion Forums) modes of communication in a web-based learning and teaching environment.</li></ul>
