SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Operations Supervisor or delegate, is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of a hot water heating plant and the performance of caretaking duties and minor maintenance repairs.

DUTIES

- Operates and maintains hot water heating plants and associated ancillary equipment, and may be required to operate a computerized energy management system and related control equipment.
- Performs a variety of manual tasks such as dusting, sweeping, washing and garbage
 pick-up and disposal and operates a variety of equipment such as vacuum cleaners,
 polishers and washers in accordance with established procedures and the Caretakers'
 Manual.
- 3. Maintains buildings and equipment by checking and testing the operation of the wet/dry fire sprinkler system, and making minor repairs to buildings, equipment and fixtures.
- 4. Maintains records, requisitions materials and assists in the compilation of maintenance records.
- 5. May respond to emergency security call-outs in various parts of the District, prepares security reports and alerts snow and ice removal crews.
- 6. May on occasion be required to perform other related duties as assigned.

- Minimum of three years related experience
- Valid B.C. Class 5 Driver's License
- Physical capability to perform the job duties
