SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Operations Supervisor or delegate, is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of a hot water heating plant and the performance of caretaking duties and minor maintenance repairs.

DUTIES

1. Operates and maintains hot water heating plants and associated ancillary equipment, and may be required to operate a computerized energy management system and related control equipment.
 2. Performs a variety of manual tasks such as dusting, sweeping, washing and garbage pick-up and disposal and operates a variety of equipment such as vacuum cleaners, polishers and washers in accordance with established procedures and the Caretakers' Manual.
 3. Maintains buildings and equipment by checking and testing the operation of the wet/dry fire sprinkler system, and making minor repairs to buildings, equipment and fixtures.
 4. Maintains records, requisitions materials and assists in the compilation of maintenance records.
 5. May respond to emergency security call-outs in various parts of the District, prepares security reports and alerts snow and ice removal crews.
 6. May on occasion be required to perform other related duties as assigned.
