SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor or Designate, installs, repairs and maintains roofs.

DUTIES

- 1. Installs, alters, repairs and maintains roofs.
- 2. Installs metal flashing.
- 3. Directs, assists and liaises with other employees, contractors, regulatory agencies and other trades, as required.
- 4. Designs projects, reads and interprets drawings and prepares cost estimates.
- 5. When required, assists other trades.
- 6. May, on occasion, be required to perform other job related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

- High school graduation or the equivalent.
- Successful completion of the BC Apprenticeship Program and a valid BC Trade Certification as a Roofer.
- Minimum of 2 years related experience at the journeyperson level as a Roofer.
- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's License
- Physical capability to perform the job duties.
