SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Zone Principal in conjunction with the Occupational Health and Safety Department, acts as the walking bus program coordinator by providing security, safety and direction to a walking school bus between home and school

DUTIES

- Pick up and deliver students to and from home and school in the morning and afternoon.
- Develop and maintain a roster of participating students, including but not limited to name, contact details and emergency contact details
- Develop and maintain a time schedule for pickup and drop off of students for home and school
- Follow the agreed upon time schedule and route, unless it becomes hazardous.
- Record pickup and drop off times of students for home and school.
- Record incidents, accidents, route alterations.
- Ensure all participants have completed registration forms and have formal approval to participate.
- Develop procedures to support a quality, safe and sustainable Walking or Riding School Bus Program
- Meet regularly with the Manager to discuss program.
- Regular on-going communication with students, parents, and school staff regarding pickup / dropoff schedule and bus depots.
- Communicate walking school bus safety rules to students and parents.
- Assist to develop "street smart" skills
- May, on occasion, be required to perform other related duties as assigned.

- Grade 11 education or the equivalent
- Ability to establish and maintain respect for and from students
- Ability to maintain accurate records
- Ability to work with schools and demonstrated understanding of road safety issues.
- Ability to work with minimal supervision
- Valid WCB Occupational First Aid Level 1 certificate.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Physical capability to perform the job duties
